Have you got your trainers ready Key Stage 1 and 2 parents? Last week, Early Years had their sports day which went really well, with a great turnout of parents cheering the children on and the weather playing its part by not raining until the children were safely back inside their classrooms.

Although I mentioned competitive parents in last week's letter, I realise it's the teachers you have to look out for! I've been informed that Miss Stolz and Miss Frazier in Reception 'took out' another member of staff, Miss Van-Eda, in order to win the teacher's race – outrageous behaviour! I do hope that the Years 3-6 Sports Day, which is on Thursday afternoon this week, will show more decorum from the staff. Next week, Year 1 and 2 will have their sports day on Wednesday 12th July from 9am—11am. Thank you to parents for coming in and supporting the children on sports day, and a big thank you to those taking part in the parents' race.

This week is 'Healthy Living Week' and the science lessons will involve a lot of discussion about how to be healthy, the importance of exercise and choosing the right food for a healthy diet. Children in Key Stage 2 will be looking at foods which contain hidden sugars and making good choices, and key stage 1 will have the opportunity to make fruit salads in the afternoon.

Please support us in this by ensuring that children are not bringing in unhealthy food as snacks. Fruit is the only snack which is allowed for break time, so no fruit/cereal bars, chocolate or crisps should be brought in to school. As part of the healthy living week, we will also be looking at healthy minds. The Ned Show, which will be visiting us on Thursday, stands for 'Never give up on your dreams,' and inspires children to persevere when the going gets tough. This fits in very nicely with our ethos of 'Growth Mindset,' where children are encouraged to rise to difficult challenges and show tenacity, something about which we feel very passionately.

Also, as part of Healthy Living Week, we will again be running Relationship and Sex Education lessons for Years 2 to 6. Thank you to those parents who came along to the parent information workshop last week. Please be reminded that, if you do not wish your child to take part in one, two or all three of the RSE lessons, we do need to get a note from you informing us of this in writing. We feel that lessons are very well tailored to each year group and are age-appropriate and would urge you not to withdraw your child. We feel that these are very important lessons to equip children for changes to their bodies, knowing what is and what is not appropriate behaviours and the importance of treating each other and each gender with respect.

For the Year 6 children who will be attending secondary schools in the borough, Wednesday will be the transition day where they will visit their new school and get a taste of things to come next September. As usual, Mrs Joda, who does a lot of work on transition, will be meeting those going to Holy Family, the school to which we usually send the highest number of children.

Finally, St Saviour's Summer Fair will be this Saturday, from 1pm-5pm - I have noticed signs have gone up around the school advertising some of the great prizes in the raffle (See this newsletter for details). If you can offer some of your time to run a stall, do face-painting or serve food and drink, please let a member of the Parent Council or Ms Tolliday, the Deputy Head, know. Otherwise, please come along and enjoy a fun day out with the family.

<u>Attendance</u>

The whole school target for attendance is **96.5%.** From the start of the school year until now, our attendance since September is **95.47%**. Please help us to ensure that children are getting the best possible education by making sure that children are in school.

Well done to **Year 1 Willow** whose attendance was **100%** week ending 2nd July 2017.

The class which had the most punctual week ending 2nd July 2017 was Year 3 Elm Well done to them! They win our Early Bird Bears for the week. We continue to have an issue with lateness and attendance. This week we had <u>52 incidents of lateness</u> and **our overall attendance is below the national average of 95.6%**. These figures are a clearly detrimental to our pupils' education. Letters have gone out to parents/carers whose children's attendance is below 90%. We are over halfway through the year and 90% is equivalent to missing half a day's education every week. Please help us to improve this.

Our Year 6 have been busy getting ready for their end of year production, please can I remind all parents/carers to bring their child's costume into school.




St Saviour's Family Service
