#### <u> Homework – Reading Update</u>

At St Saviour's, we really value home reading: not only is it a very enjoyable way to spend time with your child, it is also one of the most important ways that you can support your child's learning in school. Research shows that parents who get involved in their child's education make a big difference to how well their children do. Try to read with your child every day – little and often is best – as well as encouraging them to read independently. Please sign the yellow home-school reading book (which children need to bring in to school every day) to show their class teacher which books they are reading at home. Children in Years 4 – 6 can fill in their own home-school books but children in Years 1 and 2 may need support in this. I thank you for your co-operation in this.
