Dear Parent and Carer,

As I start my third week at St Saviour's, I find that I now know a lot of the children's names. I have met many of the parents and I am becoming acquainted with the routines. In short, I feel very familiar with St Saviour's and am enjoying working here immensely! Thank you to the parents who have dropped in to meet me this week – you have made me feel very welcome!

On Thursday last week, it was World Book Day so our assembly that morning was filled with a great range of book characters, which included many from the Harry Potter books, quite a lot of princesses, plenty of superheroes, few Gangsta Grannies and many that I didn't know (although the children were happy to explain to me). So thank you to parents for helping the children in creating their costumes - it made the day really special. Our literacy lessons that day were also special, with each year group focusing a different picture book.
