Dear Parent/Carer,

Following my thoughts in last week's newsletter, snow is now predicted for Tuesday night over the south east of England. Therefore, it is very likely that there will be a covering (3cm?) of snow on Wednesday morning. We are fully expecting the school to be open as usual but do check the website on that day if you are unsure. A reminder to parents who have to travel in by bus/car: please leave a little earlier to avoid the inevitable slower traffic on the roads that morning. One of the benefits of our soft start, where children can go into their classrooms from 8:45, is that it avoids them standing around in a cold playground for too long. I would like to remind parents and children that children should not be playing on the school field or the adventure playground in the mornings before school (the snow will make this very tempting) as they are unsupervised.
