St. Saviour's and St. Mary's school choirs attended the Young Voices project at the O2 arena in Greenwich last week.

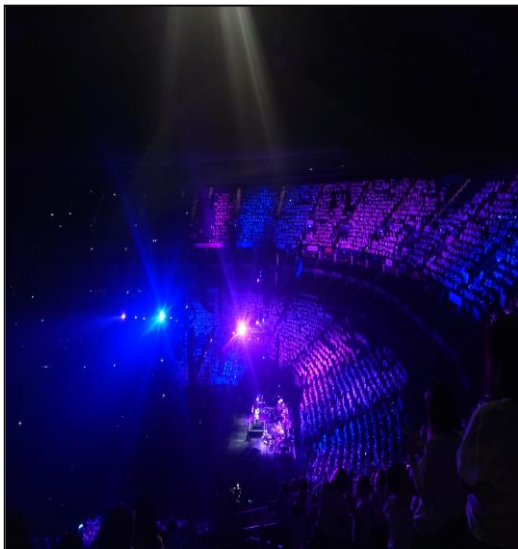
They have spent 3 months learning 13 songs off by heart, it has been a real challenge.
