
SCIENCE WEEK


Linking to our science week theme, I would like to end with a quote about time, 'There is only one thing more precious than our time and that is who we spend it on.'

YEAR 2 CLASS CORNER

In Year 2, we have been learning about the Great Fire of London which happened in 1666. We watched how quickly the fire spread due to the tall, narrow wooden houses and the impact this fire had on London.

In Literacy, our book this term also relates to this significant historical event- The Great Fire Dogs, we have been using speech to enrich our language.





In PE, we are learning gymnastic skills and practising our shapes and balances such as pike, straddle and tuck and in invasion games we have been learning how to defend and attack using balls. In Topic, we have begun to use our art skills to make Tudor houses to represent the narrow buildings which burnt down in 1966.
