

Earlier this week, the Y3 children had a fantastic time at The Hive. The visit provided a rich and engaging environment for learning, exploration and collaboration. Whether working together on activities, discovering something new or simply enjoying the experience of learning beyond the classroom, the children represented our school beautifully.

Today, some of our Year 5 pupils took part in the regional finals of the national STEM racing competition and what an incredible experience it appears to have been. They presented their work and portfolio to a panel of judges with confidence and professionalism, raced their cars with excitement and pride and spoke articulately about the process behind their designs. Events like this not only develop technical skills but also nurture teamwork, resilience and communication. We are so proud of the commitment and effort they have shown throughout the project and it certainly looks like they had an unforgettable day.



Year 6 also took part in a very important and informative assembly this week delivered by TfL, Transport for London. The session focused on keeping themselves safe as they grow in independence and begin to travel more confidently. The children engaged thoughtfully with the key messages and asked sensible questions, showing maturity and awareness. It is always valuable to reinforce these safety messages and we are grateful for the opportunity to support them in this way.

Looking ahead, we will be holding our Parent Consultation meetings on Monday 3rd and Tuesday 4th March. These meetings are an important opportunity to discuss your child's progress, celebrate successes and talk about next steps in learning. 




