Our older pupils were filled with focus and determination as children worked quickly and accurately through their 12 by 12 multiplication questions. It was fantastic to see such enthusiasm for maths and healthy competition.

Our visit to the Royal Opera House was another unforgettable experience for some of our Year 5 pupils. They attended a dress rehearsal from the English National Opera and were also fortunate enough to meet members of the cast. This behind the scenes insight into performance, rehearsal and professional production was incredibly valuable and the children represented the school with maturity and curiosity throughout the day.

We were also proud of the team who took part in the Dodgeball competition this week. The pupils thoroughly enjoyed the event, showing teamwork, agility and determination. It was clear that they had great fun while also competing with excellent sportsmanship.

As always, we would like to remind families of the importance of reading at home. Regular reading continues to make a significant difference across all areas of learning. Even ten to fifteen minutes a day can strengthen fluency, understanding and vocabulary. Thank you to those children who are reading consistently at home and building this strong habit.

Looking ahead to next week, our Year 3 pupils will be visiting The Hive for a day of orienteering and forest activities. This promises to be an exciting opportunity for them to develop teamwork and problem solving skills in an outdoor setting.

Also, a quick reminder that Year 1 Forest School and other year group sessions will continue next week. Forest School is part of the curriculum and is not optional, so please ensure your child comes prepared with appropriate outdoor clothing suitable for the weather. These sessions take place in all conditions unless deemed unsafe and are an important part of developing resilience, independence and practical skills.

We are also incredibly proud that a team of Year 5 pupils will be taking part in the STEM Racing regional finals, competing to gain a special spot in the nationals in Sheffield and streamed on YouTube, giving the children the opportunity to showcase their hard work and innovation on a wider stage. We wish them every success as they compete and represent the school.


BEATRIX Y1
